Artist Biography



Jordan Rosin (Creator/Performer)

Jordan Rosin (he/him) is a director/choreographer, actor/creator, researcher/teacher, and clown, with interests in Butoh Dance and ensemble-devised physical theatre. He also draws on yoga, acrobatics, and contact improv along with popular theatre forms like Commedia Dell'Arte, Clown, and Melodrama to create theatre and dance events with popular and poetic resonance. Jordan was co-founder & Producing Artistic Director of the physical theatre ensemble The Ume Group in New York City from 2011-2016 where he produced over 20 original works, festivals, and events and created and directed nearly all the company's mainstage productions through ensemble-based processes. He is also a frequent collaborator with the butoh company Ren Gyo Soh; and is the creator of DREAM DANCESTM.

Jordan studied Clown and Commedia at Dell'Arte International School of Physical Theatre with Lauren Wilson, Joe Krienke, Stephanie Thompson, Matt Chapman, and Carlos Gallegos, and at The Ume Group in New York City with Fabio Motta. As a practitioner of Butoh Dance, Jordan has studied with some of the world's foremost masters, including Yoshito Ohno, Tetsuro Fukuhara, Ko Murobushi, and Katsura Kan. His main teachers are Joan Laage, Vangeline (New York Butoh Institute), Diego Piñon, and Fukuhara.

As a choreographer, his credits include the internationally acclaimed *Citizens of Nowhere*, which won "Best Movement Composition" and "Most Relevant Discourse" at the 2019 Festival Internacional de Teatro Universitario at Teatro UNAM; and *Butoh Medea*, which won "Best Physical Theatre" & "Best Choreography" at the 2015 United Solo Festival and has been performed in Turkey, Italy, Scotland, Poland, Germany, Czechia and at colleges & universities across the US. Other noteworthy projects include his 2-person dance-theatre thesis *Visions of A Crying Girl* (now available for touring) and the Commedia-style *Lysistrata Project*, which he directed for The Ume Group in 2016.

Jordan received his BFA in Acting & Directing from Syracuse University and MFA in Ensemble-Based Physical Theatre from Dell'Arte International. He is a 2019 - 2021 Post-MFA Teaching Fellow in the Department of Theatre & Cinema at Virginia Tech in Blacksburg, VA.<u>www.jordanrosin.com</u> / <u>www.jordanrosin.net</u>
